Make a difference in your local community

01.

Children's Activities Volunteer Assist with play sessions, crafts, and activities for children, helping to create a safe, fun, and supportive environment.

02.

Events Volunteer Help plan, set up, and run community events such as coffee mornings, family fun days, and seasonal activities. This role is ideal if you enjoy working with people and being part of a busy team.

Fundraising Volunteer Support fundraising activities such as raffles, sponsored events, collections, and campaigns that help cover the centre's ongoing costs and keep services running.

Practical Support Volunteer Help with promotional activity, setting up rooms, tidying spaces, preparing refreshments, or light maintenance to keep the centre welcoming and well organised.

Community Garden Volunteer Support outdoor activities and play a part in creating a welcoming community garden for local residents

Community Outreach Volunteer Help raise awareness of Howgill Family Centre by sharing information within the local community, attending events, distributing leaflets, and encouraging people to access our services and get involved.

Warm Welcome Hub
